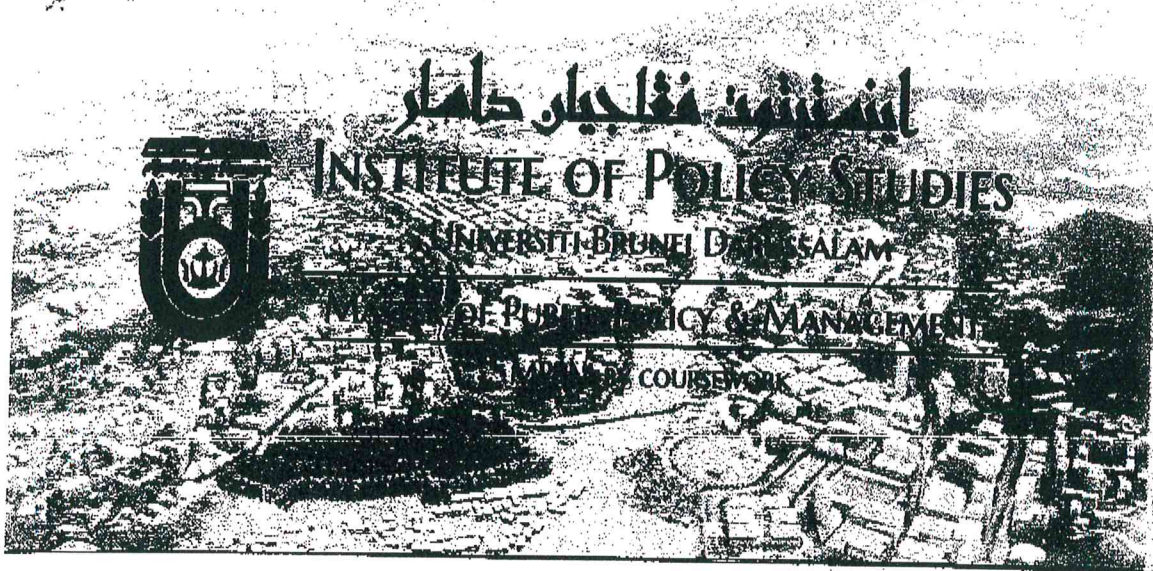

# The MPPM Programme

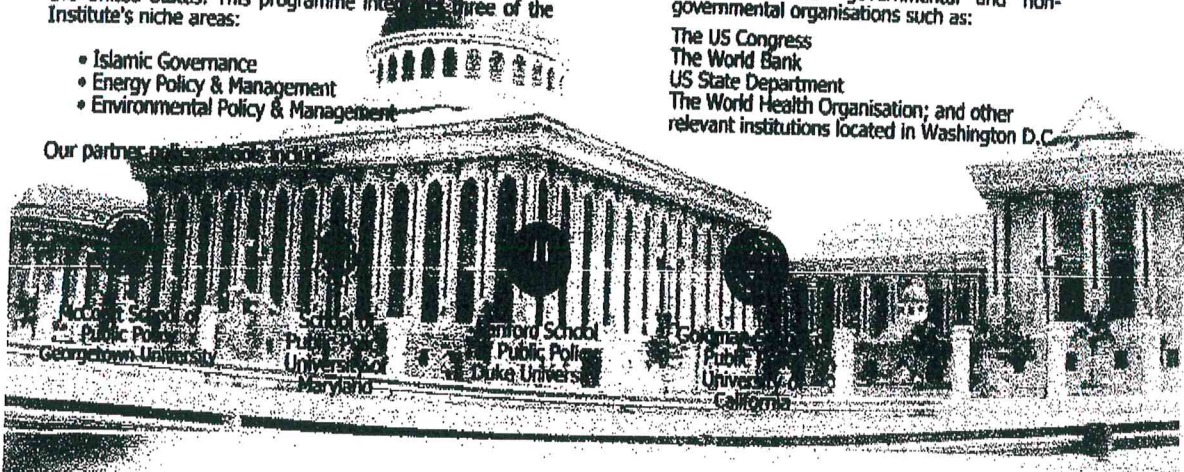
The MPPM is a 12 month graduate degree programme by coursework, that includes one semester at UBD, and the subsequent semester at one of our policy partner schools in the United States. This programme integrates three of the Institute's niche areas:

- Islamic Governance
- Energy Policy & Management
- Environmental Policy & Management

During the USA Semester, students will have an opportunity to conduct a one week Study Tour to selected governmental and non-governmental organisations such as:

- The US Congress
- The World Bank
- US State Department
- The World Health Organisation; and other relevant institutions located in Washington D.C.

## Who Should Apply?

Any interested individual from the public sector, NGOs, and other organisations, preferably with at least five years of working experience, who wish to pursue a deeper knowledge and skills in today's challenging world of policy and management, governance and leadership. Students will study a selection of Core Modules such as Policy Analysis, Public Management, Economics for Policy Studies, Quantitative Methods, Public Finance, Political Islam, Statistics and Data Analysis for Policy Makers, The Madinian Policy Visions of Islamic Governance, Policy Analysis Project, and three Optional Modules in the US Partner Policy Schools

- Second Class Bachelor's Degree and above, recognised by the UBD Senate, preferably with at least five years of working experience in a relevant field
- A minimum Credit 6 in English GCE 'O' Level, or IELTS 6.0, or TOEFL 550
- A minimum Credit 6 in Mathematics GCE 'O' Level, or Pass in a subsequent level Mathematics

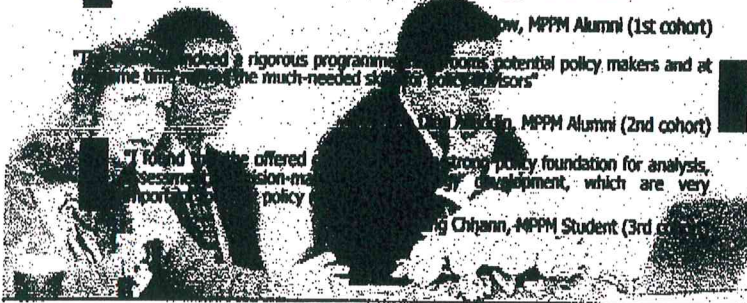
